CHAPEL DRESS CODE

GIRLS

Navy Jumper (Early Childhood).

**KCA Signature Plaid skirt or jumper (K-12),
or grey uniform pants (9-12 only).**

White Button-Down Blouse - Plain white,
oxford-style or peter pan collar; long or short sleeve;
must tuck in.

**KCA Signature Plaid Cross Tie or Necktie (K-12)
Navy Crosstie (Early Childhood).**

**Navy Vest, Sweater, Cardigan, or Navy Blazer
with KCA Logo (Optional for Early Childhood).**

White or Navy Socks or Tights - Fold down knee
socks or full-length tights; solid white or navy tights
are suitable under skirts.

Shoes - Non-Marking, closed toe, closed heel (no
wheels, lights, or Crocs).

Accessories - Hair accessories must be uniform
colors.

BOYS

Navy Pants (Early Childhood) - Uniform style.

Navy Pants (EC-8) - Uniform style.

Grey Slacks (9-12) - Uniform or dress pants.

White Oxford Shirt - Plain white, oxford-style;
long or short sleeve; must tuck in.

**KCA Signature Plaid Necktie (K-12)
Navy Necktie (Early Childhood).**

**Navy Vest, Sweater, Cardigan, or Navy Blazer
with KCA Logo (Optional for Early Childhood).**

Dress Socks - Navy, black, or white.

Shoes - Non-Marking, closed toe, closed heel
(no wheels, lights, or Crocs).

Belt - Black or navy belt must be worn.

Note: Please write your student's name inside all uniform clothing, especially
their **sweaters, cardigans, blazers, sweatshirts and polos**.

DAILY DRESS CODE

GIRLS

Pants or Shorts- Uniform style (with belt loops) in navy or khaki. Shorts are to be 2-3 inches above the knee or longer.

Skirts or Skorts- Uniform style in navy, khaki, or KCA Signature Plaid; must be 2-3 inches above the knee or longer. Modesty shorts are **REQUIRED** under all skirts and jumpers.

Jumper - Uniform style in navy or KCA Signature Plaid. Jumper 2-3 inches above the knee or longer. Modesty shorts are **REQUIRED** under all skirts and jumpers.

Polo Shirt - KCA monogrammed navy and gold.
Must be purchased from our online spirit store.

Navy Vest, Cardigan, Nylon Jacket, or Fleece Jacket - Navy vest, cardigan, nylon jacket, or fleece jacket with KCA logo (Only items with KCA logo may be worn inside the school).

KCA Sweatshirt - KCA polo shirt must be worn underneath.

Turtleneck or Undershirt - White or grey may be worn under KCA Polo shirt.

Shoes - Non-Marking, closed toe, closed heel (no wheels, lights, or Crocs).
Socks - Any color.

Belt - **MAY** be worn with uniform pants.

BOYS

Pants or Shorts - Uniform style (with belt loops) in navy or khaki. Walking shorts two inches above the knee or longer.

KCA Sweatshirt - KCA polo shirt must be worn underneath.

Turtleneck or Undershirt - White or grey may be worn under KCA Polo shirt.

Shoes - Non-Marking, closed toe, closed heel (no wheels, lights, or Crocs).
Socks - Any color.

Belt - Black - **MUST** be worn with uniform pants.

FRIDAY SPIRIT DAY ATTIRE

TOPS:

KCA t-shirt or sweatshirt, including any KCA event or club t-shirt or sweatshirt.

BOTTOMS:

Uniform pants, shorts, or skorts; Blue denim jeans, capris, or walking shorts.
No holes, distressing, or patches.

SHOES:

Tennis shoes
(no heels, wheels, or lights; no crocs, slippers, or sandals.)

On Fridays, students who do not have approved spirit attire should wear the standard Monday through Thursday attire.

FREE DRESS DAY ATTIRE:

Non-uniform clothes may be worn on specially designated days.

School administration will have the authority to determine appropriateness of attire.

Guidelines for free dress are as follows:

FIT:

All pants/ shorts/ capri/ skorts must be worn at the waist; must not have the potential to be revealing or allow underwear or skin to show; no "sagging"; no tight-fitting pants or shorts; Shirts/ blouses must cover the entire torso at all times, even in movement; Shirts must have sleeves.

CONDITION:

Pants/ shorts must be free of holes and frays; must be hemmed.

STYLE:

No yoga pants, form fitting pants, spandex, short-shorts, biking shorts, boxer shorts, or combination thereof will be permitted.

GRAPHICS:

No article of clothing or accessory may be worn that advertises drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or any other product or promotion that might defame the name of Christ.

SHOES:

Any tennis shoe or flat-heeled closed-in shoe; No 'flip-flops', shower shoes, crocs, or house slippers are allowed.

HATS:

No caps, hats, or hoods in the building unless authorized.

ACCESSORIES:

No jewelry that is too large, bulky, distracting, extreme, or flashy.

School administration reserves the right to clarify and give guidance concerning the dress code.
